

RASPBERRIES



CAROLINE: Red berries, strong “raspberry” taste, vigorous and productive plants ripen in fall. (Zone 4-7)

FALL GOLD: Golden berries, everbearing, one spring and one late summer crop, vigorous and productive plants. (Zone 4-8)

KILLARNEY: Red berries, very early summer bearing, shorter plants, most disease resistant. (Zone 3-7)

LATHAM: Red berries, summer bearing, ripen over long period, steady fruit set, old standard. (Zone 4-7)

ROYALTY: Cross between purple and red raspberries, large fruits, sweet, light flavor. (Zone 4-7)

Raspberries are self-fruitful although cross-pollination is helpful to production.

Keep red and black raspberries well separate for plant health reasons.
