| Japanese Iris - Ensata | | | | |
| E. Dinner Plate Ice Cream | Lavender | Late | 32" | Showy 8" wide periwinkle-blue flowers with white edges, fragrant |
| E. Dinner Plate Sundae - NEW! | Lavender | Early-Mid | 32" | Huge lavender-purple veined flowers with yellow center, blooms early to mid-summer |
| E. Lion King | Purple/White | Mid | 30-36" | Gigantic 7-8" double blooms, prefers moist soil |
| E. Variegata | Blue | Mid | 36" | Blue flowers with white, variegated leaves |

| G. Batik | Purple/White | Early | 24-26" | Vivid purple standards and falls with irregularly splattered and streaked white markings, award winner |
| G. Blackwater | Black/Purple | Mid | 38" | A few hints of purple in this jet black iris, velvety petals with dramatic ruffles |
| G. Breakers | Blue | Mid | 34-36" | Clean blue standards, falls and beards, award winner, rebloomer |
| G. Edith Wolford | Blue/Yellow | Mid | 34" | Stunning bicolor or violet blue and yellow |
| G. Immortality | White | Mid | 28" | Large, ruffled pure white flowers, reblooms in late summer |
| G. Mariposa Autumn | White/Purple | Early | 30-32" | White standards and falls are outlined with deep purple, multiple awards, rebloomer |
| G. Neptune's Wine | Red | Early | 41" | Very large mahogany-red flowers with hints of gold, velvety appearance |
| G. Peggy Sue - NEW! | Light Pink | Early-Mid | 34" | Fragrant light pink blossoms and striking mandarin-orange beards |
| G. Pure As Gold - NEW! | Yellow | Mid | 33" | Flowers are golden yellow and heavily ruffled, with deeper gold beards |
| G. Savannah Sunset | Orange | Late | 36-38" | Tall, intensely orange bearded iris that won't fade even on the hottest of days |
| G. Sharp Dressed Man | Purple | Mid | 34-36" | Black violet falls with purple standards, large orange beards provide contrast, fragrant, award winner |
| G. Wintry Sky | White/Blue | Early-Mid | 36" | Heavily ruffled violet blue petals and blue-white falls and beard |

| L. Black Gamecock | Dark Purple | Mid | 24" | Deep blue-dark purple flowers with small yellow streaks, good for boggy to moist, acidic locations |

| P. Albovariegata | Lavender | Mid | 24" | Green and white striped foliage, very fragrant lavender blue flowers, drought tolerant |
| Siberian Iris - Siberica | | | | |
| S. Butter & Sugar | Yellow/White | Early | 28" | Creamy white standards and buttery-yellow falls, non-fading colors, rebloomer |
| S. Caesar's Brother | Blue | Early | 36" | Deep violet-blue flowers, very floriferous, tall clumping iris with narrow upright foliage for great vertical effect |
| S. Peacock Butterfly Miss Apple | Purple/Yellow | Early | 24-30" | Multicolored flowers with shades of violet, lavender, red, yellow and gold |
| S. Peacock Butterfly Uncorked | Blue/Yellow | Early | 22-26" | Periwinkle blue standards with falls that have bright yellow centers and smokey grey-blue edges |
| S. Pink Parfait | Lavender | Early | 28" | Soft lavender pink full double flowers |
| S. Purring Tiger | Lavender/Yellow | Mid | 12-16" | Dusty lavender flowers and golden petals lined with purple veining that matches the heart of the flower |
| S. Tipped in Blue | Yellow/Blue | Early | 34" | Soft blue-violet standards edged in yellow and dotted with blue at the tips |
